1. Select the installation file for the Industrial, Auditorium or Combined Edition from the table at the bottom of the download page

Click on the Edition link in the first column. You will then be asked whether to Save or Open the compressed file.


2. We recommend saving the file to a location on your computer first and open it from there

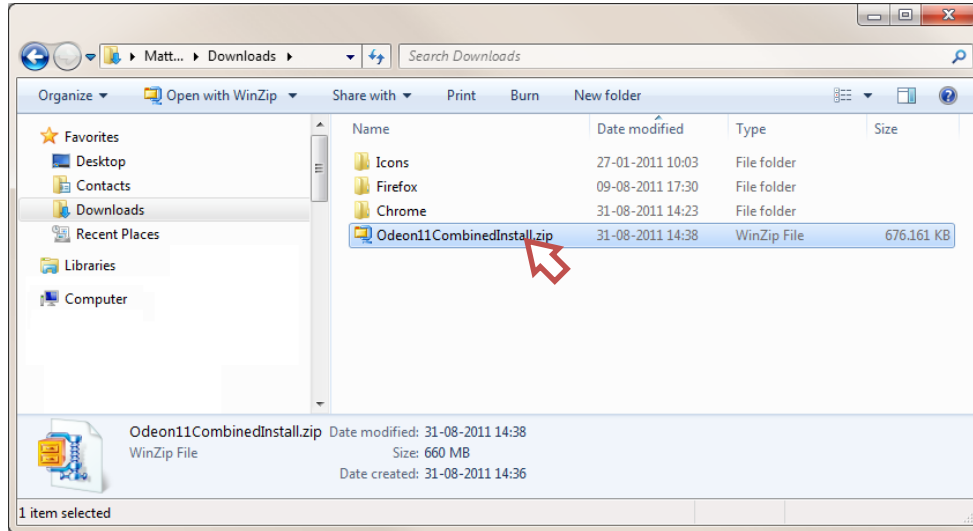
The picture above shows the options provided by Internet Explorer 9. Clicking the "Save" button will write the file to your Downloads folder, usually located in your home directory, e.g.:

C:\Users\UserName\Downloads

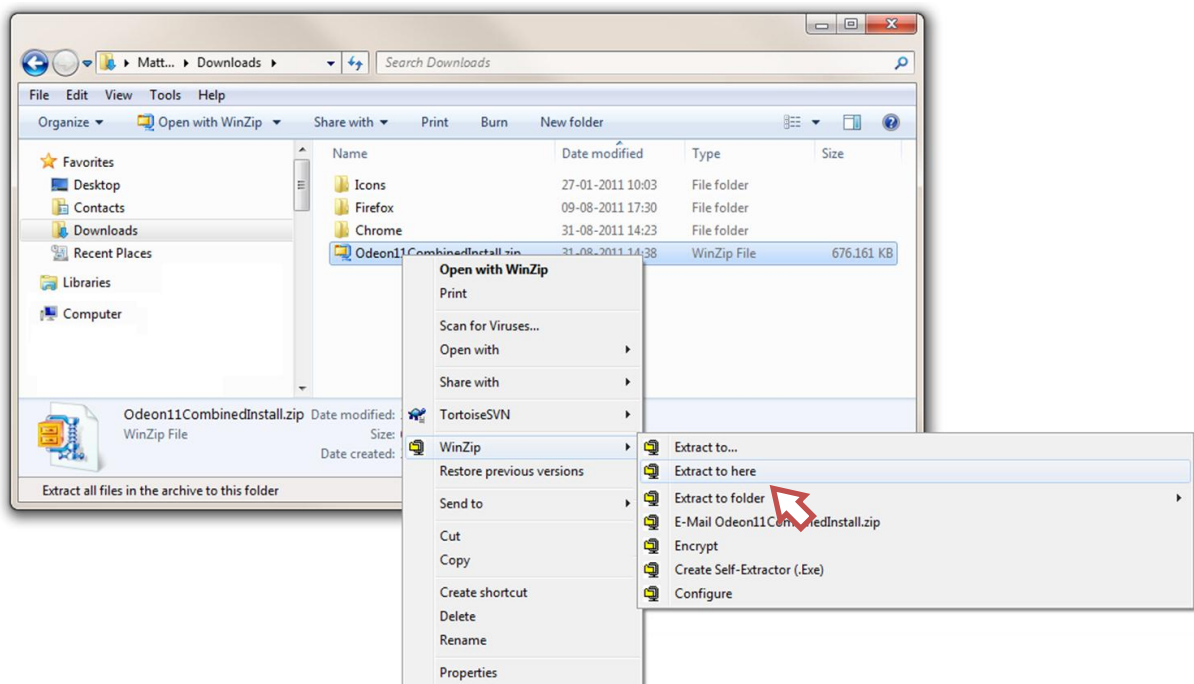
You can also save the file to any other folder, by clicking the drop down arrow, select "Save As" from the list, browse to the folder of your choice and save the file there.

3. Unzip the file's contents

Once the download is completed, go to the folder where the file has been saved. The example below shows the file located in the user's default "Downloads" folder:



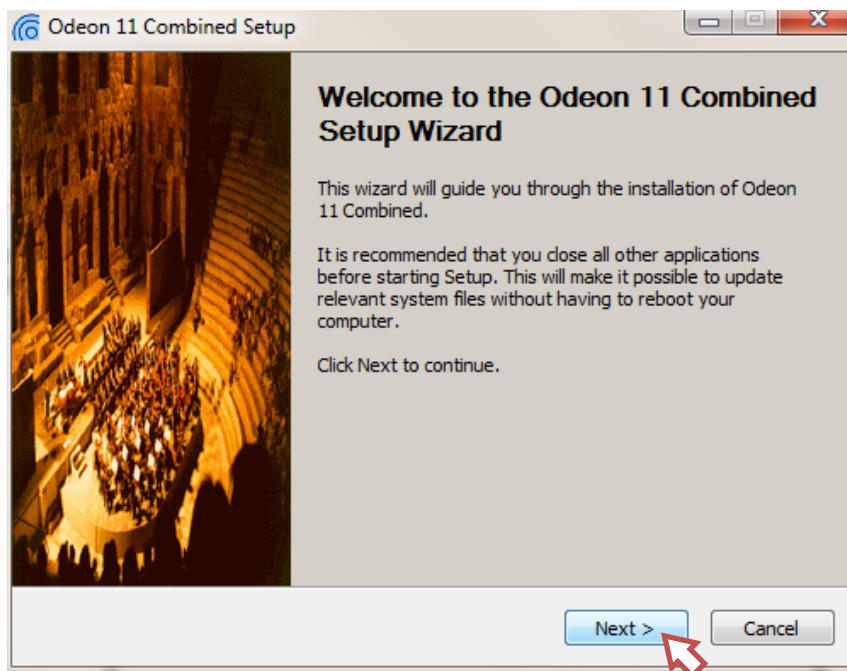
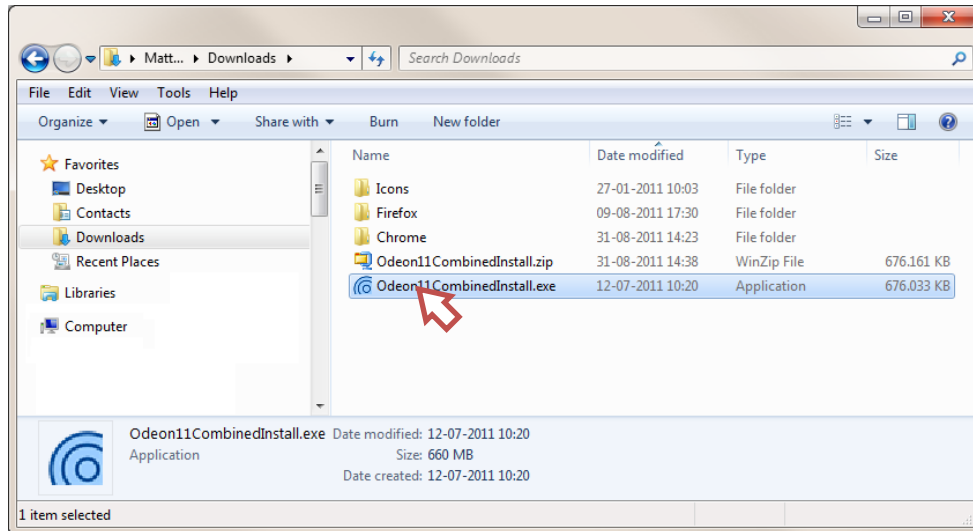
The easiest way to extract the installation files from the ZIP-file is to right click the ZIP-file and select "Extract-to here" from the menu.



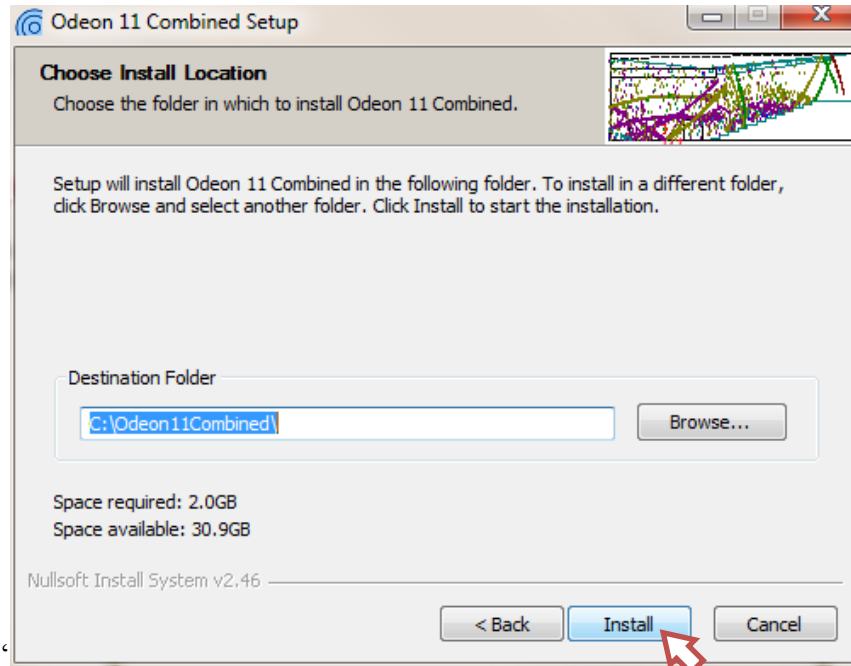
The installation file will then be extracted and saved into the Downloads folder.

4. Installation

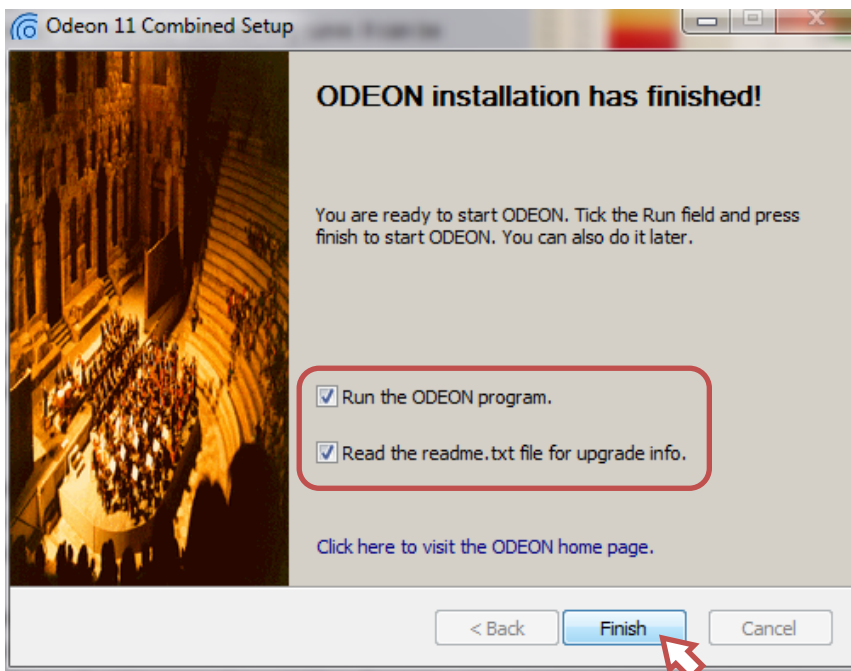
Double click the extracted Exe-file to start the installation. ODEON will then prepare the installation. This may take a few seconds.



Click the "Next >" button to continue installation. After accepting the license agreement, you will be asked to select a location for ODEON to install on your PC. By default ODEON will be installed in a folder directly on your main drive (often C:). You can change this to any other location.



Click Install after you have chosen the folder. ODEON will now be installed. After installation you can directly start ODEON and/or open the ReadMe file.



5. Deleting ZIP and Installation Exe files

After successful installation, both the downloaded ZIP file and extracted Installation EXE file can be deleted from the Downloads folder. They are not needed for program execution.
