 - 1. On the instrument, go to: Menu > System settings > Advanced settings.
 - 2. Set Service mode to Enabled.
 - 3. Scroll to Calibrate battery and press the right-arrow button.
- Have the instrument calibrated once every 12 to 24 months
 When you send the instrument into a Brüel & Kjær service centre for calibration, the battery will be checked and replaced if necessary
